## 2023 President's Research Excellence Catalyst grants awarded; Accelerator proposals accepted until May 5

Five Interdisciplinary Chin State research learns have been awarded approximately \$200.000
each in Catalyst grants through the President's Research Excellence (PRE) program in the 2023
cycle. This year's grants address research in aging, cancer, energy and sustainability. Ohio State
has invested nearly \$4.3 million in 48 teams of Ohio State investigators through the PRE
program since its inception in 2021. The PRE program is still accepting proposals for Accelerator
grants in the 2023 cycle. Accelerator proposals of up to \$50.000 are reserved for small teams
formed to pursue curiosity-driven, novel, high-risk and high-reward research. These proposals
